Through our partnerships, we ensure children born with cleft lip/palate receive all necessary services to optimize their opportunity to live fully productive lives.





# **ANDY'S STORY**

El Salvador 2022



On every trip, there is a patient who captures the hearts of the entire team. During our trip to El Salvador our team met 3-year-old Andy. Andy was born with a bilateral cleft lip and palate, as well as syndactyl toes and fingers. Andy and his mother, Yolanda, traveled for 3 hours to get to San Salvador in hopes of getting his surgery. Dr. Mahlon Kerr and Dr. Ross Blagg operated on Andy's cleft lip and palate - about a 4-hour operation.

In an interview with Yolanda, she said "My dream is for my son to be operated on, and today my dream came true." Surgery can be terrifying for children, but Andy was not afraid. His playfulness had our volunteers smiling with him as he colored, blew kisses, and played with the team. His mother, Yolanda, said she felt nervous but hopeful and voiced that with this surgery, "Todo cambiará a partir de ahora," meaning everything will change as of now.

Andy is now fully recovered and still his playful self, his mother says, "I am happy because in no other place would they have done this for him." This is just one example of the life-changing impact surgery can have on a child's life. Andy will go on to be the person he was always meant to be, and live an inclusive, fun and productive life.



## **LOCAL IMPACT**

Austin Smiles Central Texas Cleft Community provides no-cost wraparound care to over 800 patients annually. We offer social & emotional programming, referrals, speech therapy, special needs assistance, newborn & surgery care kits, parent advocacy, and education. The impact of Austin Smiles programming can last a lifetime, as children make new friends and realize they are not alone.
