

Dear Friends and Supporters,

We are excited to share that we had another year of incredible growth! Thanks to your support, we have expanded both locally and internationally, reaching more children than ever before. Our international footprint continues to grow with the addition of two new medical mission sites to San Pedro Sula, Honduras and Puebla, Mexico. At each new location, Austin Smiles was able to serve many children who had waited far too long for a surgery. Locally, we expanded nutrition supports, bilingual speech therapy services, and quarterly social and emotional programming. Mental health services have also increased with our quarterly, peer-led support group for new and expectant parents of children with cleft conditions. We are also thrilled to offer semiannual preventative dental care days. These expanded initiatives on the local and international level highlight our commitment to providing comprehensive cleft care to some of the most vulnerable children.

Next year, Austin Smiles celebrates 40 years of smiles! Over the past four decades, we have served close to 10,000 lives, bringing hope, self-confidence, and life-changing care to children who might otherwise go without. Our work would not be possible without the selfless dedication of our volunteers and the generosity of our donors.

Many children struggle with self-esteem and require mental health support. Austin Smiles believes every child born with a cleft lip or palate deserves access to life-changing care.



Austin Smiles evaluates all patients, and every patient receives care, answers, and support. In addition to surgery, we provide speech therapy, dental care, obturators, eating and feeding therapy, and nutrition support. Families are supported months before and after surgery, and all patients are welcomed back the following year for reevaluation. Our goal is to walk with each patient through their cleft care journey into adulthood—and when a patient needs services beyond our scope, we refer them to trusted partners.

Patient Stories

PATIENT STORY HONDURAS 2024

Meet Ángel, a young boy from Paraíso, Honduras. His family **traveled over seven hours by bus to reach the hospital in San Pedro Sula**, hopeful for help. Ángel's parents learned of his cleft condition during a prenatal ultrasound. The diagnosis was confirmed after a follow-up scan.



"As parents, it was devastating," his father said. **"We were filled with anguish and heartache thinking about the pain and difficulties our child would face."** Ángel's mother heard at church about a medical mission coming to the area. The family found a phone number, contacted Austin Smiles, and registered for the surgical brigade. **"I feel emotional and above all, grateful to God for putting you in our path,"** his father shared. **"This opportunity was more than we ever expected. Surgery like this is so expensive, and we could never have afforded it on our own. But now, my child has a chance—he is healing, and we can look forward to his future."**

With tears in his eyes, he added, **"My dream is to support my son in whatever he chooses to do. I couldn't finish my own education because of money, but I will do everything I can so that he can go further. Thanks to you, he now has that chance."**

PATIENT STORY VERACRUZ

Meet Jesus, a young boy who has benefited from Austin Smiles' care for two consecutive years. In 2023, he received his initial cleft lip repair. Despite having a very complex cleft, the surgery—**completed in under two hours**—normalized his appearance, **reducing stigma for his family and enabling him to eat and speak more easily as he grows.**

This past year, Jesus returned for his full cleft palate repair, a critical procedure that will support his speech and language development. With these surgeries, Jesus is on the path to living a full, healthy childhood, able to communicate, learn, and play like any other child.

His journey illustrates the lasting impact of returning care and the difference Austin Smiles makes by **supporting children at every stage of their treatment.**

NEW PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT - Parent Support Groups - Austin, TX


The stories shared by caregivers in our Parent Support Group have demonstrated how impactful connection can be for families navigating cleft care. Parents have reported improved understanding of their child's condition, greater advocacy skills, and stronger mental and emotional well-being.

- "It's not something that you just fix and move on. She'll always have a struggle — **it's my job to appropriately advocate and help her understand her place in the world.**"
- "People called me a 'helicopter mom,' but they weren't there **when I handed my 3-month-old to a surgeon or spent nine days in the NICU.**"
- "We're not as different as everyone else. **Every child has something they have to go through. This is just our experience.**"
- "We found out in the delivery room, and **it was quite a shock...** the hardest part was breastfeeding and surgery at 11 months. **It hasn't always been easy, but you overcome it**—and one day it becomes a happy memory of, **'we did it.'**"
- "When I saw her, I was like, **'We were meant to be your parents'... She was perfect for us.'**"
- **Confidence is a skill.** We have good days and bad days, but tomorrow is a new day and it's about continuous improvement. Give yourself grace.

Through these support groups and other new services, we remain committed to our mission of supporting the whole child and family at every stage of their journey.


